NTPS Nurses & Midwives Enterprise Agreement Bulletin 1

The NTPS N & M Bargaining has commenced. The first negotiation meeting was held on Friday 13th May 2022. This meeting was attended by representatives of the Office of the Commissioner of Public Employment, the Department of Health and Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (NT Branch).

Discussion occurred around the NTPS Bargaining Policy, this establishes the bargaining parameters for Enterprise Agreements. (Please see attached NTPS Bargaining Policy). The Commissioner provided an outline of the proposals (employer claims) put forward by DoH and the Commissioner's office.

ANMF NT put forward the members Log of Claims (LoC), to the Commissioner and DoH. You can access the LoC on the ANMF NT website www.anmfnt.org.au in the member's section.

Future meetings will be held fortnightly, over the coming months.

It is the intention that we will work together in good faith over the coming months to reach agreement for a proposed new agreement. The Commissioner has indicated it is her intention, that a formal offer will be put to employees by 3rd August 2022.

N.B. The current NTPS Nurse & Midwife Enterprise Agreement expires on the 20th August 2022.

Next bargaining meeting will be held on Tuesday 31st May 2022.
