NTPS Nurses & Midwives Enterprise Agreement Bulletin 7

ANMF NT met with OCPPE & DoH yesterday, negotiations have progressed and they are almost finished. However, the negotiations remain ongoing. Please see **Overview of ANMFNT member claims – Employer response** document attached. PLEASE NOTE: the overview is an ANMF NT's analysis of bargaining so far.

What happens now?

Bargaining will continue on outstanding items.

The Commissioner for public employment and DoH will now consider their position on the proposal (offer) that they will be putting to Nurses and Midwives.

When the new proposal (offer) is provided to ANMF NT, the office will survey members and seek your view on whether to accept or decline the employers offer.

NTG Wage Policy

The NTG has not changed their position on the Wage Policy. As stated in bulletin 6, it has been made very clear at all meetings that ANMF NT **DO NOT** support the NTG Wage Policy, which is in fact freezing your wages and conditions. The wage policy will only cause harm to the nursing profession into the future, in regard to retaining and recruiting staff, which will in turn put more pressure on an already overburdened health system.
